

Gold Level

Cost: \$30,000

Overview: Our Gold Level program is designed for those who prefer a highly structured training regimen with maximum professional involvement.

- Your dog will either participate in several board and train sessions throughout the program or attend day school three days a week.
- This ensures consistent, high-quality training from experienced professionals, resulting in a well-trained service dog.
- You will meet with your trainer weekly for an half hour-long private lesson. During these sessions, you'll learn to handle your service dog and ensure you're comfortable with the cues and behaviors your dog has mastered.
- Additionally, you'll participate in a monthly group outing. These outings provide real-world experience and practice, allowing you and your dog to navigate public spaces confidently.

This program is ideal for owners who want to ensure their service dog is trained to the highest standards while receiving ongoing, personalized support from professional trainers.

Silver Level

Cost: \$20,000

Overview: The Silver Level program offers a mix of professional training and owner involvement, making it ideal for those who want to play a significant role in their dog's development while still benefiting from expert guidance.

- Your dog will attend day school in a two-weeks-on, two-weeks-off pattern. During the "on" weeks, your dog will be immersed in focused training sessions.
- In the "off" weeks, your dog will attend day camp one day a week, giving you more time to work with your dog at home.
- You will meet with your trainer every other week to review progress, learn new exercises, and address any challenges.
- Additionally, you will participate in the monthly group outing to reinforce your dog's training in real-world settings.
- Daily practice with your dog on the exercises set forth by your trainer is expected to ensure continuous progress and reinforce the training.

This program is perfect for owners who are committed to actively participating in their dog's training journey, with ample support and guidance from professional trainers.

Bronze Level

Cost: \$10,000

Overview: The Bronze Level program is designed for owners who are ready to take on the primary responsibility for their dog's training with support from professionals. This program provides a solid foundation and ongoing guidance to ensure success.

- The program begins with an initial board and train and/or day school program to jumpstart your dog's training.
- After this initial phase, your dog will attend our day camp program once a week to continue their development.
- You will meet with your trainer for a once monthly hour long private lesson to review progress, set new goals, and refine your training techniques.
- Participation in the monthly group outing is also included, offering valuable real-world experience for both you and your dog.
- Daily practice is essential, as you will be responsible for working with your dog on the goals and tasks set by your trainer.

This program is great for owners that feel confident in working with their dogs on their own but want guidance and accountability for their service dog journey.

Payment Details for All Programs

Down Payment: A \$2,000 down payment is required to begin any of our service dog training programs.

- ⇒ If you already have your puppy/dog prospect, they must pass an initial temperament test. Passing this test is not a guarantee that your prospect will become a service dog. If Skyward Service Dogs finds you a puppy, the cost of the puppy is not included in your program.
- ⇒ If for whatever reason if your prospect is washed from the program any unused training tuition can be used for a future prospect. If the training is not yet paid off you are liable for the remaining balance for your dog's training received.

Monthly Payments: After the down payment, you can make monthly payments on a sliding scale, with a minimum payment of \$325. These payments are due each month until the total cost of the program is paid off.

This flexible payment structure is designed to accommodate various financial situations, ensuring that our programs are accessible to those in need of a service dog.

A monthly statement will be issued for your records.
